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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear WJB Public School Community,

I hope that you are well, staying safe, and enjoying the summer. You should have received a letter from our Director, Robert Bratvold, on Monday, August 24th outlining the options available to you as you make decisions about the upcoming school year. We understand the concerns many of you have regarding a full school return and know that each of you will make the right choice based on your family circumstances.

We are looking forward to welcoming students back to WJB Public School and we are working hard to ensure that the health and safety of our students and staff remains our top priority. By now, you have heard about the Re-entry plan that our school has in place. If not, you can find our Re-Entry Plan on our school website (https://bz.srsd119.ca/). We are also working very hard to keep our classroom cohorts together as much as possible. This has been recommended by the Provincial Health Officer (PHO) to reduce the number of close, in-person interactions within the school. This will limit the number of people each student or staff member comes into contact with, thereby reducing the risk of transmission of COVID 19 and ensuring quicker contact tracing by health authorities should that be necessary.

Learning Groups in our school will be organized in groups of approximately 30 or less. This will mean that most classrooms will form a Learning Group on their own and within this group, while strict physical distancing won't be required, physical contact must be minimized. Aside from Learning Groups, there are a number of additional changes that you will want to discuss with your child. These include:

Increased and Routine hand washing

□ Changes in classroom layout to allow for greater spacing between students

Removal of hard to clean objects

Reduction or greater management of shared materials

More individual and smaller group activities

Staggered recess and lunch times to allow for greater play space on the playground

Designated pick up and drop off spots at arrival and dismissal to allow for greater distancing. Please bring your child to the school as close to bell time as possible to reduce congestion on the playground (8:35am)

Staggered and supervised entry and exits to maintain distancing between classes

Increased outdoor learning time

 Adults outside of a learning cohort will be maintaining physical distance and wearing a mask (E.g. Educational Support Teacher, Librarian, Music teacher, Counselor, Mentor)

□ Please note that masks are required for all staff and students in grade 4-8.

There will be additional cleaning and disinfecting, physical barriers, hand washing stations and sanitizer available throughout the school including portables, and increased signs and other visual cues. Most importantly, we ask for your continued diligence in ensuring that your child remains home if they show any symptoms of common cold, influenza, COVID 19 and other infectious respiratory disease before sending them to school.

While our bell schedule has generally remained the same, you will see that we will be splitting recess and lunch to reduce student density in outdoor play spaces. Students will brought out for recess by their classroom teachers. The Ministry has provided time on to allow students to adjust to new classrooms, new routines and properly review and practice health and safety protocols.

Please be assured that we are working hard to plan for a positive learning experience for your child and look forward to the year ahead.
