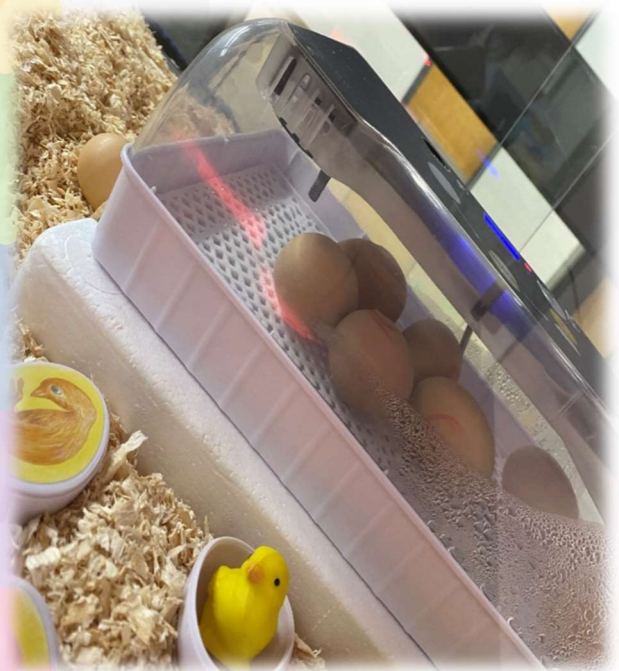
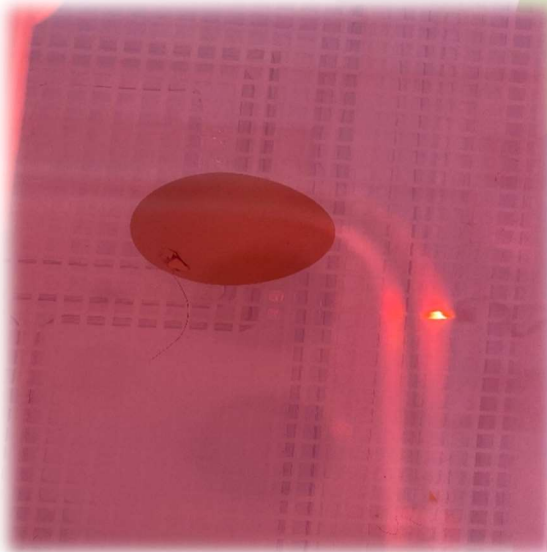


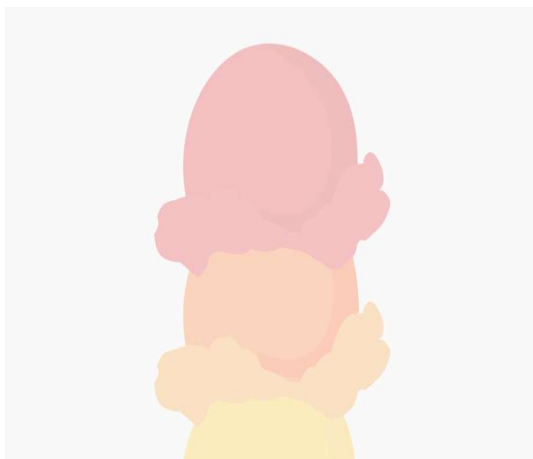
WJB CHICKEN ADVENTURE
