Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up Safety Reminder

- We kindly ask that you do not use the staff parking lot for student drop-off or pick-up at any time. This area is reserved for staff and service vehicles only. When cars enter and exit this lot during busy times, it creates unnecessary congestion and increases the risk of accidents involving children and pedestrians.
- Additionally, please avoid making U-turns in the school zone. These sudden and often unexpected maneuvers pose a significant danger to students, families, and our crossing guard who are navigating the area—especially during peak times before and after school. As a reminder, in the province of Saskatchewan, U-turns in a school zone also carry a hefty fine and an SGI demerit points penalty!
- We know how precious your time is, and we appreciate your efforts to follow these important safety guidelines. By using the designated drop-off zones and driving with caution around the school, you are helping to protect the well-being of every child in our care. Thank you for doing your part to keep our school safe!
